

Mission and Vision

The UNIDO Institute aims to enhance Member States' industrial policymaking capabilities by generating, disseminating and sharing world-class knowledge resources, and building capacities for the formulation and implementation of strategies towards creating shared prosperity, advancing economic competitiveness and safeguarding the environment.

The Institute:

1. Develops research and policy analysis capabilities by enhancing the potential of government officials to plan sustainable industrial development processes and improve their capacities to implement policy reforms.
2. Promotes UNIDO's development knowledge and disseminates its expertise, experience and practical approach;
3. Advocates new solutions to industrial development challenges and best practices, and builds capacities for more effective policy management;
4. Acts as a global forum building dialogue and partnerships between policymakers, the private sector, universities, research institutes and civil society.

All of the Institute's programmes rest on three pillars: (1) policy dialogue and training, (2) research and analysis, and (3) a global community of practice.



Research

UNIDO conducts applied economic research on the patterns of structural change and disseminates its findings both within the organization and to development practitioners. On this basis, it advocates the relevance of accelerated and environmentally sound industrial development as instruments to reduce poverty and increase sustainability. It supports Member States in the analysis for policy design to expand and diversify their productive capacities, and it advocates for inclusive and sustainable industrialization strategies at the global and regional level. Functions include:

- Provide evidence-based analysis of the process of economic growth and industrial structural change in the context of the global economy.
- Convene national, regional and international forums to acquire and disseminate knowledge and expertise, and raise awareness on the role of sustainable industrial diversification and competitiveness policies in economic development.
- Contribute to the production of the Industrial Development Report.
- Support in the advocacy of industrial development in achieving the SDGs and other internationally agreed development goals.

Industrial Development Report

The Industrial Development Report series is one of UNIDO's flagship publications. It is intended to build on development policy experience and contribute to a refinement of the international development agenda. The reports provide guidance to policy makers and assist both public and private stakeholders to formulate, implement and monitor national strategies for effective poverty reduction through sustained productivity enhancement.



Capacity Development

The UNIDO Institute works with policymakers, technical experts, industrial development practitioners, researchers, academics and other stakeholders as well as with learning institutions to foster the analytical, technical and networking skills that support effective industrial policy formulation and implementation. It conducts the following programmes.

Global Executive Programme

These intensive short courses are aimed at senior officials from relevant ministries, public sector institutions and national regulatory agencies. With inputs from thought leaders and experts in the field of industry, technology and innovation, participants are provided with a forum for the exchange and acquisition of knowledge that can help strategize innovative approaches and shape sound industrial policies.

Professional Programme

The professional programme gathers mid level policymakers, industry leaders and representatives from civil society promoting inclusive and sustainable industrial growth through capacity building. It aims to ensure informed and timely policymaking and to strengthen institutions/infrastructures that are part of the enabling environment for effective industrial development.

Summer Programme

These courses enhance the knowledge base of young professionals and researchers in selected thematic areas related to inclusive and sustainable industrial development. They offer a dynamic mix of traditional and innovative teaching methods and are supported by e-learning tools.

E-learning

Making use of its own Moodle-based e-learning platform, the UNIDO Institute for Capacity Development offers high-quality e-learning courses in UNIDO's core fields of expertise.
